Whole Project due date May 22- Other dates mentioned below are suggested to help you keep on track with the project.

Complete by March 13 ___ Write a basic profile of the raptor you were given to study?

Does the profile include at the very least:

- A description
- What would be their prey
- Some of their habits
- Where they might live in the wild, where might they be found today, are they only found in one geographic region, where
- Nest type describe it
- Your wiki page should have:
 - Colorful title
 - separation lines (horizontal rules)
 - at least one picture of your raptor from a source that allows use of the photo and the photo is properly cited below it with title of the photo, name of the photographer, location of the photo and where on the web the photo may be found
 - Links to other pages by you in the wiki

Complete by March 24 ___ Chose an observation activity from the **Science Observation Skill Builders** link on the Observation form page in the wiki, record on a page linked to you wiki page two of the observation skills activities?

___ Make at least 3 observations of a nesting raptor? (*One in each month March, April and May*)

Complete by April 24 ___ from the following three activities select one. Then do the activity three times making changes and improvements in the drawing, poem or story. Take criticism from others and be critical of your own work

- Write a poem about your creature
- Draw a picture of your raptor or a feature of your raptor that is as realistic as possible with each drawing make improvements.
- Write a fictional story about a raptor, bat or bee that includes details about this creature
